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Chairman's Report January 2019

I am pleased to report a very good calendar year and must hope that 2019 will be as good.

The Group has held some most enjoyable events, including visits to Cowbridge and Kew Gardens, with strong participation - attendance and conversation! Many thanks to all those who made these events so good and we look forward to more members participating in the future.

As regards membership the Committee felt that there was a closer relationship with the Development Office during the last year. This is important for us as they are key to sending out invitations to join. This worked very well as we welcomed 63 new members, including 18 women, to bring membership to 295 strong. This is great and a step forward toward gender balance! Indeed we hope that whilst all members are encouraged to join the Committee, (we have one vacancy now), a female member would be especially welcome.

The College goes from strength to strength helped by the full funding of our XL Network Bursary. This Bursary is in perpetuity and was supported by more that 50 members. Once again, thank you all. We are leaving a permanent mark on supporting our College's aim of not allowing finance to preclude study. The final annual amount of the bursary is not available yet but we usefully surpassed our £100,000 target.

Our Group aims no longer include fund raising but our previously funded Post Graduate, Exhibition and Undergraduate bursaries are still going strong. Last year we supported 27 awards and since 1990 we have helped almost 200 members of College. A proud record which it would be so nice to extend. If this strikes a chord with you, increased or new donations are always welcome.

Running alongside the Group has been support for the College's Summer School, a new College Essay prize and encouragement/'top-up prizes' linked to Oxbridge essay competitions. There is a small fund (held in our Group's accounts), arising from the First Principal's Plaque at Abergavenny Priory initiative, which has enabled this support.

Returning to our events, the JCR, (Jesus Curry Recusants), meeting every couple of months in Fleet Street continues to have great support and even greater conversations! Do try to come and, for those not in London, is there any prospect of developing something similar elsewhere? Details are on the website.

We welcome new ideas for events, initiatives...- we will always investigate support for proposals. To this end, on the morning following the All Alumni Dinner we will again encourage discussion of the way forward over mid-morning coffee. (We will also be stimulated - after the night before!- by a talk and questions from one of the graduates that we have supported.)

Finally your thanks and mine are due to your committee without whom the meetings, communications and web-site would not happen. In return, we thank you for your support and encouragement.

Treasurer's Report

Membership

The Accounts for the year ended 31 July 2018 are enclosed.

There were three social events during the Group's financial year. The visit to the Wallace Collection attracted the expected attendance but the event in Cowbridge achieved greater participation than budgeted and so generated a surplus. Old Members' Day was also well attended and made a surplus (and generated £98 in donations for the Awards Fund). Payments were received for the visit to Kew Gardens in September 2018 which falls in the following accounting year.

The closing surplus at 31 July 2018 was £1,067. The surplus is held to support social activities (including website costs and paying deposits ahead of collecting fees) and as a contingency. To put this amount in context the Group turnover on a 2-day event is typically around £2,500 with deposits required of £300.

The bank account was also holding £5,034 being the balance of donations for the Outreach project in Wales. Expenditure was incurred on promotional material, essay prizes (£500) and expenses.

JOMG Awards

On behalf of the beneficiaries, I would like to thank everyone who supports the JOMG Awards.

All new donations are managed by the College's Development Office and distributed through the College's Annual Fund in accordance with members' wishes. Awards (other than our contribution to undergraduate bursaries) continue to bear the Group's name.
